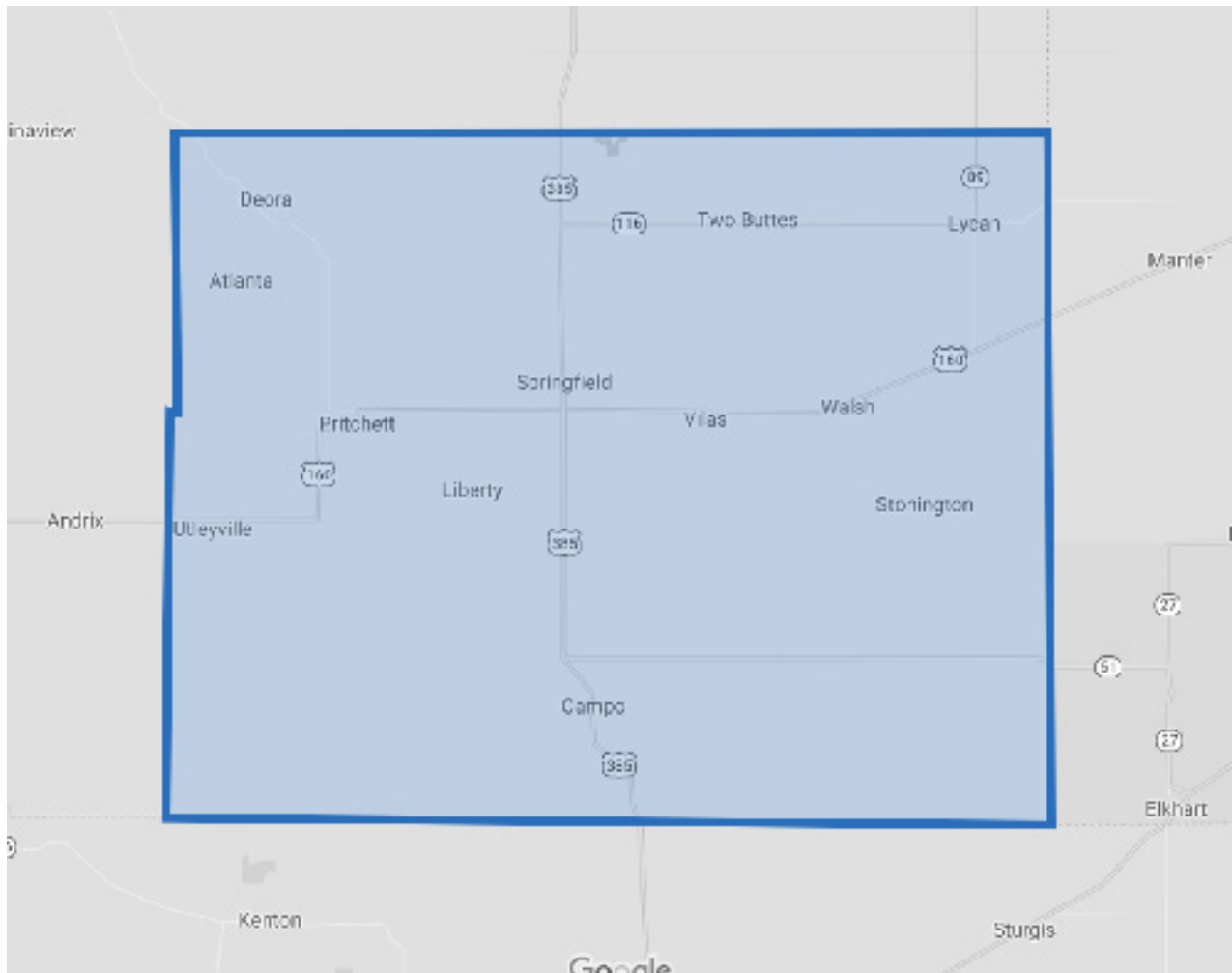

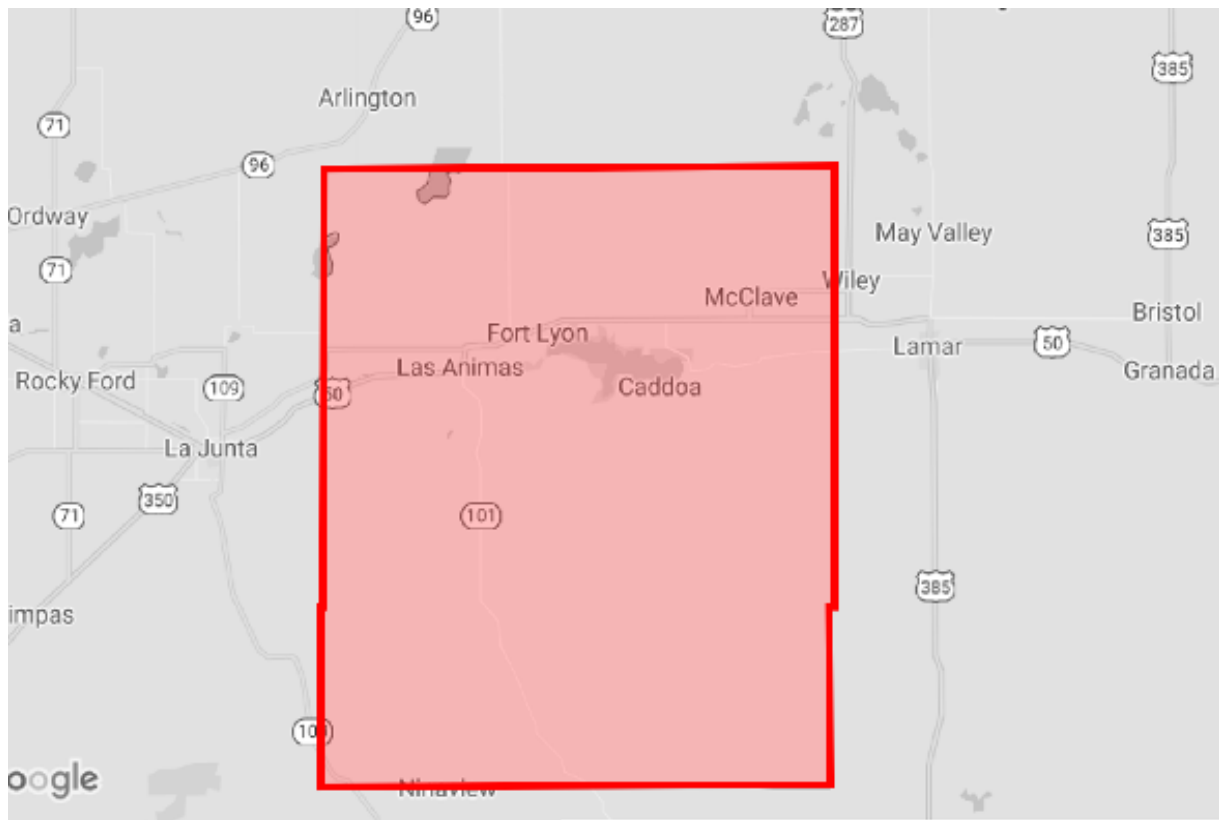

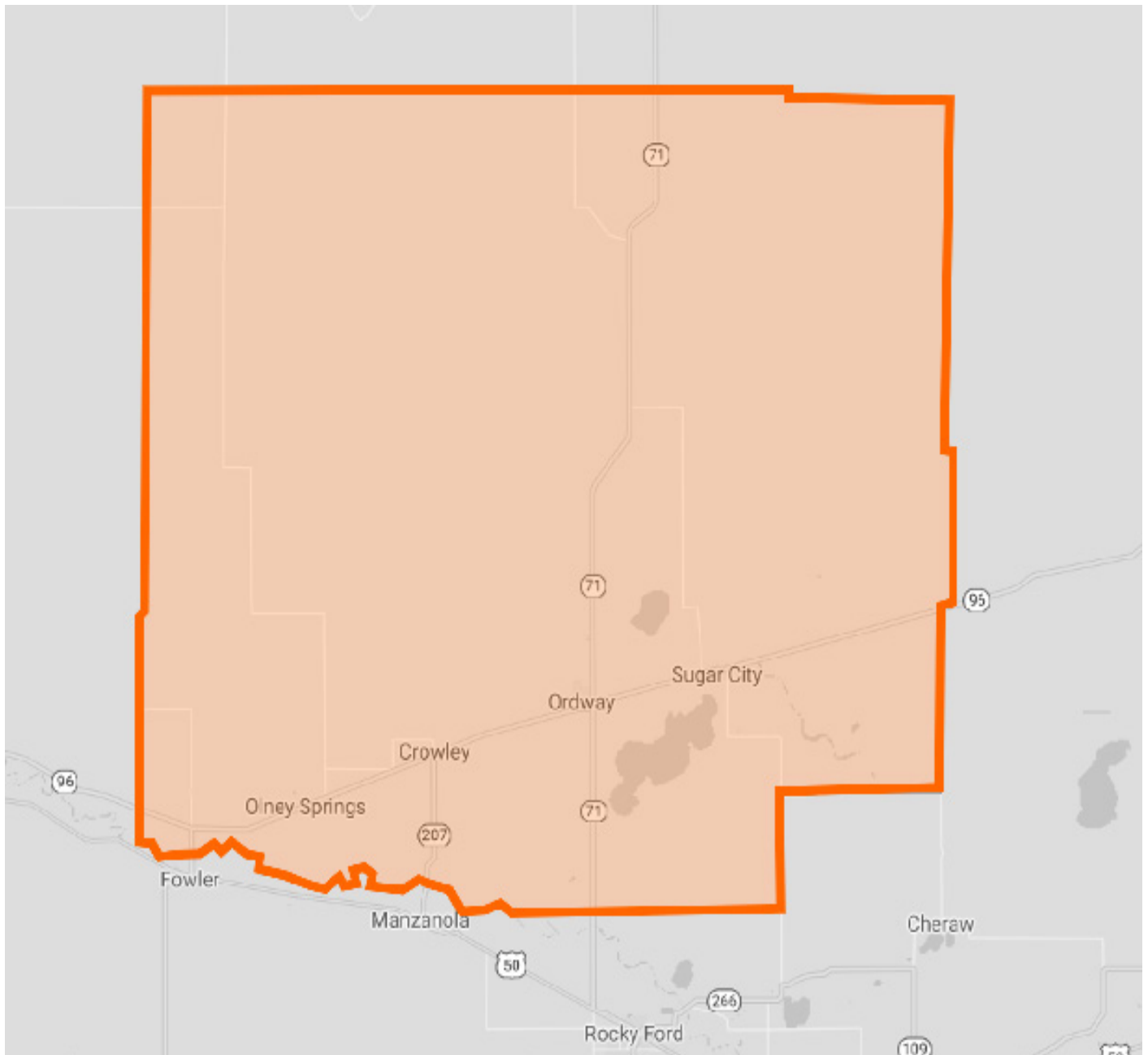

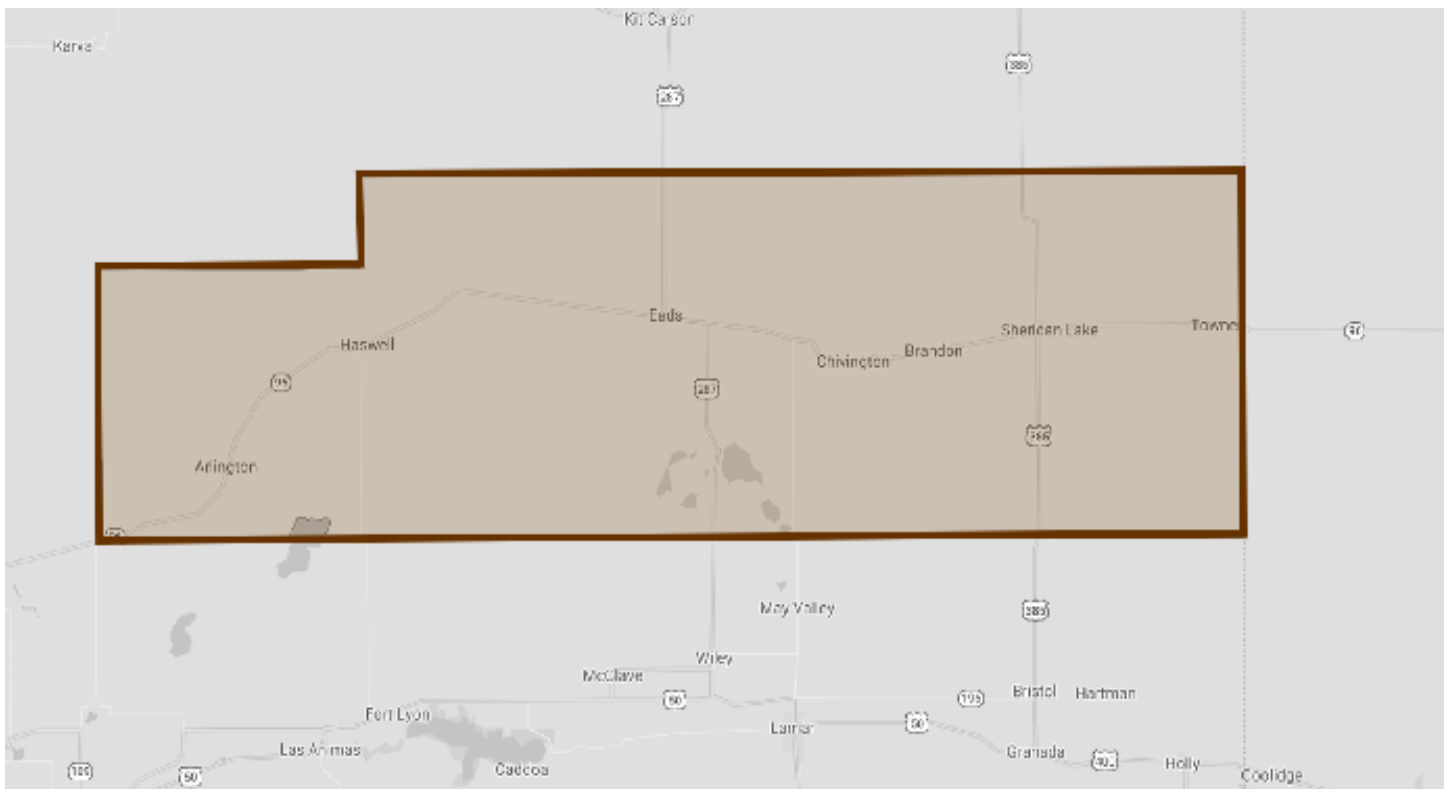

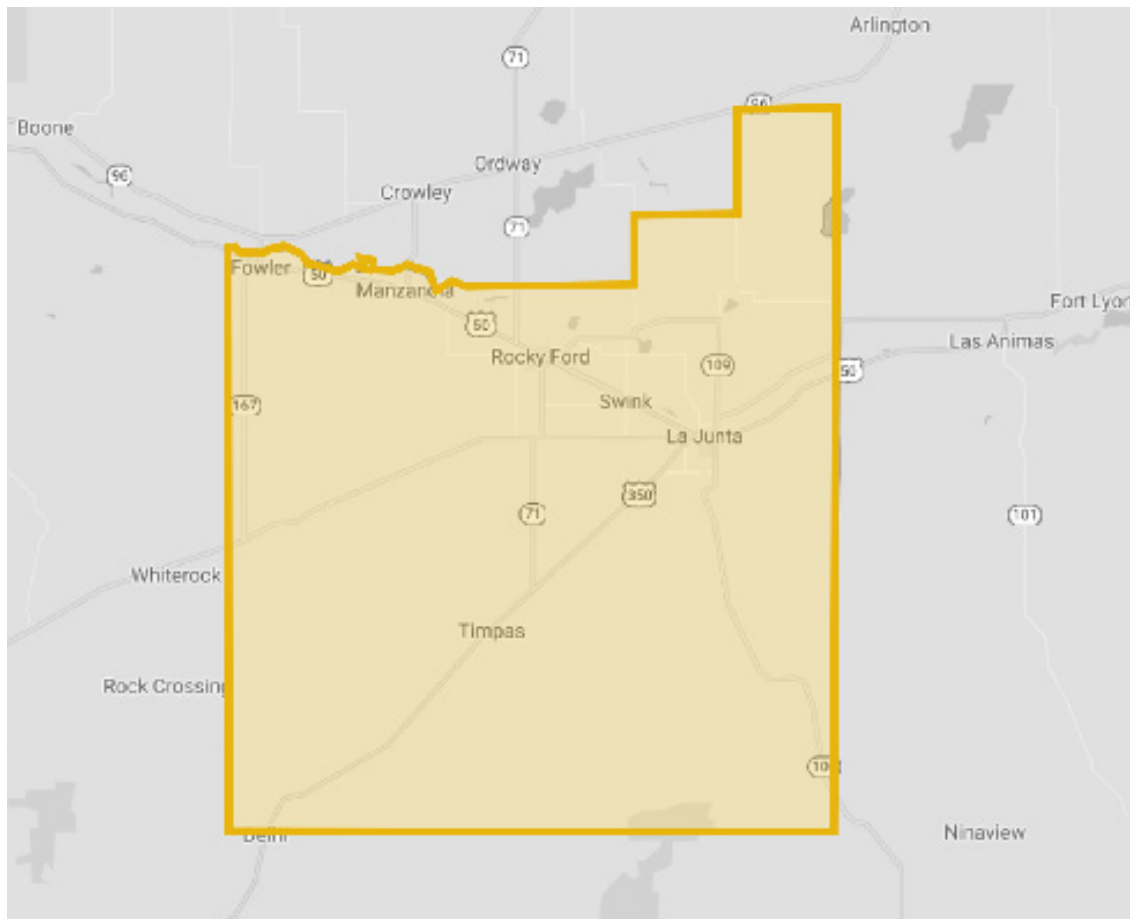

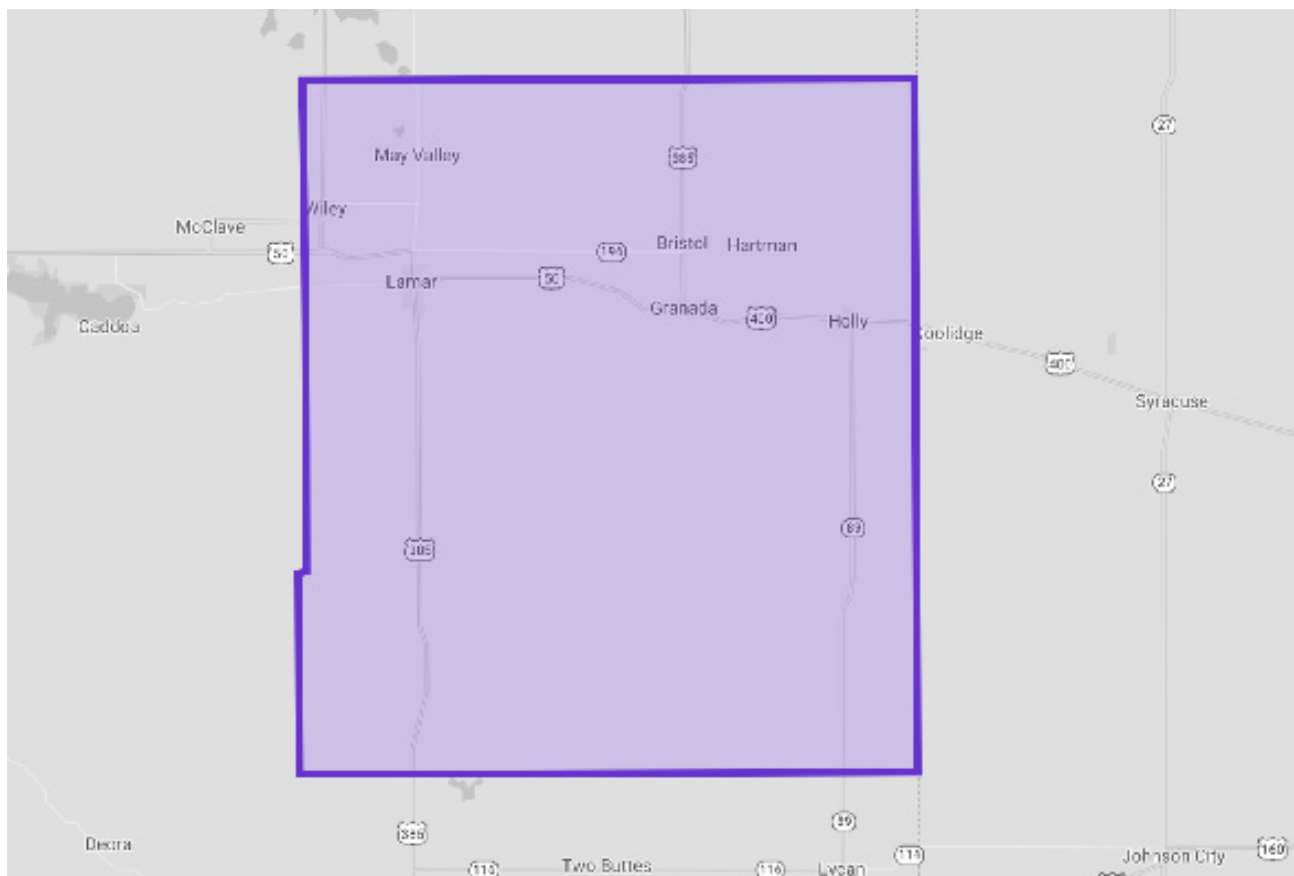

Fixed Routes
